

**Terms and conditions of the “Use data-mining techniques to monetize available social and financial data” Competition**

1. This terms and conditions (hereinafter referred to as Terms) stipulate the rules and conditions of the “Use data-mining techniques to monetize available social and financial data” Competition in a hackathon event such as HackYeah and is an annex to the general terms and conditions of HackYeah Hackathon.
2. The Hackathon Sponsor and promising prize within the meaning of art. 921 § 3 of the Civil Code (Journal of Laws 2017, item 459) is UBS BUSINESS SOLUTIONS POLAND SP. Z O. O., with registered office in ZABIERZÓW, registered under numbers: NIP (Taxpayers ID no): 6762358128 and REGON (Business ID no): 120538258, entered into KRS (National Court Register) under number 0000289222.
3. Details of the task will be presented at the start of the competition.
4. Participation in the "Use data-mining techniques to monetize available social and financial data" competition may be taken individually and in teams of up to five people who have started solving the competition task no earlier than 13:00 on October 28th and forwarded the task for evaluation no later than 12:30 pm on October 29th. The task submitted for evaluation should be signed with the names and surnames of the authors.
5. "Use data-mining techniques to monetize available social and financial data" Competition is thought for at a minimum 2 teams. Otherwise it will be cancelled.
6. Participants related or affined to the second degree with members of the “Use data-mining techniques to monetize available social and financial data” Competition Jury as well as with promising the prize, are excluded from participation.
7. The Competition is to present the solutions to the problem (closed/open task). The solutions of respective tasks will be evaluated by a Jury assigned to a respective task, consisting of at least two members. The prize in the competition for a winner is "Samsung Gear VR 3 with Controller" and "UBS Goodies" for 2<sup>nd</sup> place.
8. The solutions should be teams' or individuals' own ideas and should not violate proprietary rights.
9. Jury and Jury members' decisions are final and cannot be appealed.
10. Any alterations or revisions made after the statutory time is expired are illegal. Any alterations and revisions made after the statutory time is expired will not be considered by the Jury.
11. Author's proprietary copyrights to the awarded solution will not be transferred to the Competition Sponsor.
