

Terms and conditions of the “Chat to EU” competition

1) These terms and conditions (here in after referred to as “terms”) stipulate the rules and conditions of the “Chat to EU” competition taking place within the scope of the event HackYeah 2019 and is an annex to the general terms and conditions of HackYeah Hackathon.

2) The Hackathon Partner (here in after referred to as Competition Partner) within the meaning of art. 921 § 3 of the Civil Code (Journal of Laws 2017, item 459) is European Commission Representation in Poland, with registered office in Warsaw, ul. Jasna 14/16A, 00-041 Warsaw, Poland, registered under following numbers: NIP (Taxpayers ID no): 526-22-66-405 and REGON (Business ID no): 016145298, which may be reached at COMM-REP-POLAND@ec.europa.eu e-mail address.

3) The contest organizer and the promisor, as defined in article 921 § 3 of the Polish Civil Code (Dz. U. 2017, item 459), is PROIDEA Sp. z o. o. with its seat in Kraków (30-651), Łabędzia 9, NIP: 679-308-88-42, REGON: 122769022, entered to the register of entrepreneurs under the number KRS 0000448243, which may be contacted at biuro@proidea.org.pl.

4) The details of the task will be presented at the start of the competition on the Hackathon website: www.HackYeah.pl.

5) Participation in the “Chat to EU” competition may be taken individually and in teams of **up to six people** who have started solving the competition task no earlier than 12:00 September 14th, 2019 and forwarded the task for evaluation no later than 12:00 on September 15th, 2019. The task submitted for evaluation should include: project title, team ID, project description, snapshots, PDF presentation, demo link and be signed with the names and surnames of the authors. **Jury will evaluate only those solutions submitted by the Participant that constitute complete and independently operating applications/programmers.**

6) Participants related or affined to the second degree with members of the “Chat to EU” competition Jury, as well as with promising the prize, are excluded from participation.

7) The Contest task consist of presenting solutions for the provided issue. The jury assigned to the task, consisting of at least two members will select the best solutions

from amongst the submitted solutions. The contest prize amounts to 5000 EUR, (five thousand euros), including tax.

8) Jury and jury members' decisions are final and cannot be challenged by the participants of the competition in course of any appeal procedure.

9) Any alterations or revisions to the submitted solutions made after the statutory time is expired will not be taken into consideration by the jury. Any alterations and revisions to the submitted solutions made after the statutory time is expired will not be considered by the Jury.

10) Author's proprietary copyrights to the awarded solution will not be transferred to the Competition Partner.

11) By taking part in the contest the participants confirm that:

a) they are the sole authors of the solution submitted to the contest and that they hold all the necessary copyrights to the aforementioned materials and that those rights are in no way limited or encumbered by third party rights;

b) the submitted solution does not violate any rights or personal interest of third parties or the regulations of the law in force; the participants also undertakes to hold **Proidea** (as the Organiser of the Contest) harmless against all liability on account of violation of those rights and regulations as well as any liability related to the fraudulence of the representations given in this item B,

c) the submitted solution is an original solution, hitherto unpublished and not awarded any prizes in any other contests.

10) Jury members will be posted on HackYeah website no later than on September 13rd 2019.

11) Participation in the competition means acceptance of all terms of the hereby Contest Rules.

12) The Partner may cancel organization of the contest without providing a specific reason.
